

# Centennial High School Choir Spring Trip

Winter Park, Colorado

March 30-April 3, 2022

## General Information

The CHS Choir travels annually to engage in performance, competition, and expose students to historical and cultural events as part of our effort to provide a well rounded educational experience in our program. Trips vary each year to provide different opportunities for students to travel and perform throughout their high school experience.

## Winter Park Ski Music Festival

The Winter Park Ski-Music Festival has been a favorite destination of high school choirs, bands, and orchestras for over 30 years. The festival is known for its outstanding value, safety record, and performance opportunities. The trip will include:

- Roundtrip Transportation Via Charter Bus
- Lodging at Snow Mountain Ranch YMCA Resort
- 3 Days of Lift Tickets (Winter Park Resort)
- Ski, Boot, Poles, Helmet or Snowboard Rentals for Duration of trip
- Beginner Ski Lesson with Winter Park Ski School
- Non-Skiers receive 5 vouchers to be redeemed for Winter Park Resort Activities
- Performance / Competition in Music Festival
- Award Ceremony and Street Dance in Winter Park Town Center
- 2 Breakfasts (at cabins)
- 3 Dinners (at cabins)
- 3 \$15 meal vouchers to use at resort for lunch
- Trip T-Shirt
- Trip Insurance Policy (for weather related travel delays)

## Student Registration

All students enrolled in the CHS Choir program are eligible for travel on this trip. The choirs will engage in competitive performance during this trip. In order to create performing ensembles trip registration will be prioritized by choir. Registration will be accepted on the following schedule:

Students can register by returning the trip contract and \$125 non-refundable deposit. In order to maintain the advertised cost we must fill a minimum number of seats on each bus. When student registration reaches (40) participants we will begin a waiting list. All students that wish to travel should be registered no later than **October 1**. Should we reach capacity on our trip we will create a waiting list in the order that payments are received. In the event that a travel place does not become available on the trip, students on the waiting list will have deposits refunded.

## Chaperones

There will be a limited number of reduced cost chaperone packages available for this trip. In an effort to provide an opportunity for as many students as possible adult travel will be limited to those needed to support the students. An application for chaperones is available on our choir website at [www.centennialhschoir.com](http://www.centennialhschoir.com). Applications will be reviewed after October 1.

## Loss of Student Travel Privileges

Payment of travel fees does not guarantee the student right to travel. Please note that consistent discipline problems in school (both in and out of choir) may result in the loss of travel privileges. Any flagrant offense of school or district policy will result in the loss of travel privileges. Students must maintain academic eligibility in order to engage in travel per our states no pass, no play policy. Students who lose travel privileges for any reason will be refunded at the rate corresponding to their loss of travel privileges in the travel contract.

## Payments

Payments can be made via check to the CHS Choir Booster Club or CutTime. Deposits will be collected via the registration on the CHS Choir webpage. If you wish to make your first payment with a check or cash, select this option on the form and bring payment to Mr. Cooley during school for processing. You will be added to the trip when both the payment and the contract are received.

## TRAVEL & PAYMENT CONTRACT

This contract between \_\_\_\_\_ (Student), \_\_\_\_\_ (Parent/ Guardian) and the CHS Choir, commits the Student to participate in the department's trip, to Winter Park, CO March 30-April 3rd, 2022

The above parties agree to the following:

1. The cost of the trip is estimated at \$690-\$700 inclusive, per the itinerary. The price of the trip may increase or the trip may be cancelled if a minimum number of travelers is not met. If cancelled for this reason all deposits will be refunded. Should price increase above the estimated maximum, students will be given the option to withdraw from the trip with no monetary penalty. Withdrawals due to trip price increase must be made before December 1, 2021.
2. Registration is complete with the receipt of this travel contract and a **non-refundable** \$125 deposit. After bus capacity is met, students will be put on a waiting list. Any student remaining on the waiting list at the time of travel will have their deposit refunded.
3. Anyone wishing to withdraw from the trip for any reason must notify the choir office in writing. Any refunds will be processed according to the payment schedule in this contract as it corresponds to the date the written notification is received.
4. Students can be removed from travel as a result of school related discipline problems, loss of academic eligibility, or violation of the BISD behavior policies. If a student is removed from travel a refund is available per the payment schedule in this contract as it corresponds to the date the student is officially removed from the trip by the choral directors or school administration.
5. All payments for the trip will be made on time and per the schedule below. Reminders will be sent via email prior to each payment deadline. If a payment is more than 10 days late the student's place on the trip will be forfeited to the next person on the waiting list. A refund is available per the schedule below.
6. District required chaperones will be selected first from district personnel, then Choir Booster Officers, and finally from other choir parents wishing to travel. An application for chaperones is available on the choir website. Chaperone positions will be filled after October 1.
7. Performance is an important component of this trip. Some preparation for the performance will occur outside of class time. Ample notice will be given to students of extra rehearsal responsibilities for this trip. Students will be required to attend rehearsals and perform as part of their travel on this trip. A student who does not attend required rehearsals and cannot successfully perform the required music will be removed from the trip.
8. Students must be academically eligible in order to travel.
9. The student and parent must attend the required Pre-Trip Meeting on Tuesday, March 8, 2022, 6:00pm at CHS.
