The success of the CHS Choral Department is dependent upon each individual choir student adhering to the policies and procedures set forth in the Choral Department Handbook. Additionally, Singers are expected to adhere to these standards and act in accordance with District, Campus, and Department Codes of Conduct.

Requirements of the course include, but are not limited to, student participation in the Fall Concert, Winter Concert, Pre-UIL & UIL Concert & Sight-Reading Assessments, the Spring Concert, and any other activities or designated organization performances. Regardless of event classification (extra or co-curricular), attendance of those eligible to participate is state-required element of their participation in this course. If a student fails to meet the designated performance requirements, he/she will experience a reduction in their assessment grade and risks suspension from performing with the organization. Any deviation from this policy will be at the discretion of the director.

All student absences will be handled in accordance with BISD, CHS, & Choral Department policies. Reasonable consideration will be given with regards to conflicts with UIL and other school sponsored events. In the case of a family emergency and/or personal illness, the student named above agrees to notify the Choir Director of the situation **and** to furnish a supportive documentation for this absence upon their return to school. Students and parents must communicate with all sponsors IN ADVANCE and IN WRITING in order to allow time for proper resolution of any schedule conflicts.

The \$70 Fair Use Fee must be paid or a Payment Contract submitted for the student to receive school uniform pieces and participate in the performances of the department. Failure to comply with this policy will result in an unexcused absence from any performance for which the student does not have a proper uniform to participate.

Payments to the CHS Choir cannot be refunded because of a students inability to participate because of academic eligibility, failure to meet requirements of the policies in this handbook, removal or leaving the choir program, and/or the decision to not participate in an activity after a payment deadline.
