General Information

The CHS Choral Department is excited to offer our students the opportunity to travel to Nashville and Memphis, Tennessee this year as a part of our endeavor to engage our students in artistically and culturally significant learning experiences during this time at Centennial High School.

Student Registration

ALL students enrolled in the CHS Choral Department are eligible to travel with the Department.

To register for this year's trip, students should return a completed contract and a minimum of \$100 to secure their seat. Once initial deposits are received, participants will receive information about how to set up their online trip account with our travel agent, US Integrity Tours. Initial payments may be made to our Booster Club during Choir Prep Day. Enrollments will be accepted through October 10th.

Due to the limited availability of seating on the bus, we are only able to accommodate 50 participants for this trip. Should enrollment exceed the number of seats available, a waiting list will be created. In the event that seats does not become available, students/parent travelers on the waiting list will have 100% of their deposits refunded.

Notice: Any deposits made prior to the clearing of fair-use fees for the 2019-2020 school year will be used to clear outstanding balances first. Any balances remaining after fees have been cleared will be forwarded to USIT for use in securing your spot for this year's trip.

Chaperones

The number of positions available to chaperones will depend on the number of students desiring to travel. Currently, eight positions are reserved for adult travelers, including staff and required district personnel. The final number of positions available to adult travelers will be set by October. Loss of Student Travel Privileges

Payment of travel fees does not guarantee the student right to travel. Please note that consistent discipline problems in school (both in and outside of class) may result in the loss of travel privileges. Any flagrant offense of school or district policy will result in the loss of travel privileges. Students must maintain academic eligibility in order to engage in travel per our states no pass, no play policy. **Students who fail the 4th Six Weeks Report Card will not be permitted to Travel.** Students who lose travel privileges for any reason will be refunded at the rate corresponding to their loss of travel privileges in the travel contract.

Payments

Initial deposits for this year's trip will be made to the Centennial Choir Booster Club and can be made with cash, check or your student's CutTime account.

Once deposits are received, students/parents will receive an invitation from our trip management software issued to us by US Integrity Tours. Through this portal trip participants will submit their medical forms, food requests, contact information, and complete any and all future payments. Email reminders will be sent out 7 days prior to each payment deadline. Balances will be tracked and reminders distributed for each monthly installment until trip balances have been paid in full.

The cost for this year's tour is estimated between \$790-\$835 for Student Travelers (Quad Occupancy) and \$915-\$955 for Parent Travelers (Double Occupancy). Trip costs are based upon a minimum of 40 paying participants traveling with our group. Trip price will change should these minimums not be met.

Nashville/Memphis, TN Trip Contract - March 12-16, 2020

This contract between _____ (Participant's Name) and the Centennial High School Choral Department commits the party designated above to participation in the CHS Choir Spring Trip to Nashville/Memphis, TN currently scheduled for March 12-16, 2020.

1. The cost of this trip is estimated between **\$790-\$835** and is inclusive of all admissions, travel costs, and meals as outlined in the cover page of this contract. This price point is based upon a minimum of 40 participants registering to participate by the October payment deadline. Should this minimum not be met, the price of the trip may increase or the trip may be cancelled. If the trip is cancelled due to low enrollment, all deposits will be refunded. Should the price of the trip increase above the estimated maximum, students will be given the option to withdraw from the trip with no monetary penalty. Withdrawals due to trip price increase must be made prior to the November payment deadline.

2. To complete registration, all travelers must complete a return a **signed contract and a non-refundable deposit of \$100** to the CHS Choir Booster Club. Reservations will be filled according to the order in which contracts and deposits are received. Should trip enrollment exceed the number of available seats on the plane, a waiting list will be created. Students remaining on this list at the time of travel will be refunded.

3. **All payments for the trip will be made on time and per the schedule below.** Initial deposits will be made to the CHS Choir Booster Club. All subsequent payments will be processed through the online portal set up by our travel agents, US Integrity Tours. Reminders will be sent via email by USIT prior to each payment deadline. Students and/or chaperones who do not maintain their accounts may be removed from the trip and their spot made available to another participant.

4. **Students wishing to withdraw from the trip for any reason must notify the choir office in writing.** Any refunds will be processed according to the refund schedule outlined by our travel agent in our trip contract. Initial deposits are non-refundable unless the trip is cancelled.

6. **Students may be suspended from participating in this trip as a result of school related discipline problems, academic ineligibility, or serious violations of the CHS Choral Department's behavior code.** Refunds for those removed from from trip will be administered in keeping with the payment calendar set by USIT.

7. **Students must be academically eligible in order to compete and travel.** If a student should be found ineligible at the conclusion of the 4th six weeks, he/she may not be allowed to travel with this organization. Grade checks will be conducted throughout the spring to assist students with tracking their status. **Students who lose eligibility during this time will not be eligible for a refund.**

Having read the above agreement for this tour, the Student and Parent hereby commits to fully participate in this opportunity. **I, understand and hereby agree that this deposit is non-refundable as noted above.**
